Announcements:

1. Sue Miller gave an update on the status of the Nevada County Fairgrounds as it pertains to availability for the 2021 quilt show. While the outdoor grounds have reopened for daytime public use there has been no release for use of the buildings beyond the Main Street distance learning venue for students during the school week. Permission for the resumption of these activities must come from the state, and there has been no indication of when that may happen. Barbara Ceresa asked that any ideas for alternative guild show activities or venues be emailed to her in preparation for the November 12th board meeting where this situation will be discussed. The quilt show board will also participate.
2. Sophia Day shared the news that Chuck Maddox, the husband of member Betty Maddox, has died. He was a great friend of the guild, supporting its early formation when Betty served as the first president in 1984, providing assistance with equipment for the shows, and offering storage for that equipment at their memorable "John Deere Home" in Nevada County. Betty and Chuck had recently moved to live with their daughter Joanie Hartung.
3. Jeanne Pincha-Tulley shared that member Marjorie McConnell has recently moved to Junction City, Oregon.
