General Meeting Minutes

Announcements:

Barbara Ceresa:

1. The guild lost one of its charter members on October 1st with the passing of Bertie Brem. Bertie was an active member of the guild from its beginning in 1984, serving in leadership roles through the years that included president, vice-president, quilt show chair, and chair of a number of committees including scholarship, quarter yard club, and beginner basics. When the Hall of Honor was created in 1999, Bertie was one of the four members inducted. She was also selected by her fellow members as the Featured Quilter of the 2002 quilt show. The guild extends sincere condolences to her family and will always be grateful for Bertie's friendship and her dedication to the pursuits of the quilting craft in Nevada County.
2. Nominations for the Hall of Honor are now being accepted and should be submitted to Vice President Lillian Glaeser by the November meeting on Tuesday, November 3rd. The nomination form was emailed with the October newsletter. It can be completed online and forwarded to Lillian, or printed and sent through the mail.
3. Community Service will be open on Thursday, October 15th, from 9 am till 1 pm., at the guild's work/storage rooms at the rear of the Nevada County Historical Society building, 161 Nevada City Hwy. Masks are required. Contact Nancy Holtz with any questions.
4. Nevada County and the Nevada County Fairgrounds are creating a partnership to open a distance learning and youth hub in the Main Street Building that will be leased through June. What this will mean for other uses of the building, i.e. the quilt show, has not been addressed. At this time the PTQG does not have a signed contract for the May 2021 show.
5. The Country Christmas scheduled for Thanksgiving weekend at the fairgrounds has been cancelled.
6. Sophia Day: The election for the 2021 Executive Board resulted in a majority of the respondents approving the continued service of the current office holders: President Barbara Ceresa, Vice-President Lillian Glaeser, Treasurer Kathy Mollett, and Secretary Sheri Doerr. The proposed one-time reduction in 2021

membership dues for renewing members was also approved. Lorna Straka noted that the President's Quilt will be a two-year service recognition for Barbara Ceresa to be assembled next year.

SHOW AND TELL:

Photos of quilts were submitted by 10 members prior to the meeting and organized by Holly Miner into a slide show. This show included pictures and explanations of sewing rooms, as well as quilts.
